

# NEWTOWN CULTURAL ARTS COMMISSION 2022 Project Grant up to \$1,250

The Newtown Cultural Arts Commission will distribute up to \$1,250 in one or more project grants to an individual artist residing in Newtown and up to \$1,250 in one or more project grants to a Newtown based group, club, or arts organization that enriches the cultural life of the community, for a total of \$2,500 in grants.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The grant recipient(s) must be at least 18 years of age and a Newtown resident or Newtown organization, group or club. Note: Family members of Newtown Cultural Arts Commissioners and/or NCAC Project Grant Selection Committee members are NOT eligible to apply.

**DEADLINES:** Complete application and supporting documentation (incomplete or late submissions will not be considered) must be postmarked, or received, at the First Selectman's Office, Newtown Municipal Center, 3 Primrose Street, Newtown, CT 06470 by **April 15, 2022.** 

**AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT:** The NCAC will announce the grant awardees by email, on our website and via press release on or before **April 30, 2022.** 

**DISTRIBUTION OF AWARD:** Awards will be distributed in accordance with project schedules as outlined by the organization or individual artist. It is the intention of the commission that the project will be completed within one year.

#### **HOW TO APPLY:**

- Complete the NCAC Grant Application Form.
- Submit two letters of support/recommendation or articles published about your organization, group or club.
- If your application includes a study opportunity or workshop, please include a bio of the instructor.
- Agree to be interviewed, if requested.

## **Project Requirements**

All grants under this program share the following project requirements. Please certify all requirements with a check mark in each box.

1.	Grant application forms must be legible and complete.
2.	Projects should be completed within one year of the date the grant is awarded.
3.	The project must enhance the arts in the Newtown community.
4.	Applicants must be 16 years or older and individual or organization must reside in Newtown, CT. Applicants under 18 must have a parent or guardian co-sign.
5.	Applicant agrees to acknowledge NCAC's financial assistance on all publicity and promotional material in a legible font.
6.	Access to participation in the project will not be limited on the basis of national origin, race, religion, age, or gender.
7.	No grant funds can be used for payment of debts incurred before the start date or after termination of the project.
8.	Projects must not include publishing that is initiated solely by the applicant (i.e., vanity press).
9.	Funds may not be used to pay for credits or materials necessary in order to fulfill degree requirements for students.
10.	Activities must not be for religious purposes.
11.	Grant funds cannot be used to support strictly commercial activities, projects intended for mass-market distribution or those that have profit as the direct primary motive.
12.	Newtown Cultural Arts Commissioners and NCAC Project Grant Selection Committee members and their families are not eligible to apply for this program during their tenure on the Commission or Committee or within 6 months of their resignation from the NCAC or NCAC Project Grant Selection Committee.
